Climbing Chulu West Peak is a challenging mountaineering expedition that requires technical skills and experience. The peak is located in the Annapurna region of Nepal and stands at 6,419 meters (21,055 feet) above sea level.

The climb usually starts with a trek to the Annapurna region, where climbers can acclimatize to the altitude. The ascent involves traversing glaciers and negotiating steep snow and ice slopes and may require climbing equipment like crampons, ice axes, ropes, and harnesses. Additionally, climbers should be prepared for unpredictable weather conditions and altitude-related challenges.

Annapurna Foothills Treks offers a customized Chulu West Peak climbing package 13 Days, including a guide, porters, permits, camping equipment, and transportation.

The package does not include daily expenses such as food, accommodation, and drinks. You will also need to bring your gear.

Day 2: Trek to Chame, 5-6 hrs, 2,670, m/8,758 ft

Day 3: Trek to Pisang,5-6hrs, 3,200 m/10,497 ft

Day 4: Trek to Manang,5-6 hrs, 3,540 m/11,612 ft

Day 5: Acclimatization day in Manang, 3 hrs, 3,750m /12,136 ft

Day 6: Trek to Letdar, 4-5 hrs, 4,200 m/13,777 ft

Day 7: Trek to Chulu West Base Camp, 3-4 hrs, 4,810 m/15,777 ft

Day 8: Trek to High Camp, 2 hrs, 5,100 m/16,729 ft

Day 9: Ascent to Camp I,4-5 hrs, 5,530 m/18,139 ft

Day 10: Chulu West 6,419 m/21,055 ft Ascent and Decent to High Camp (Summit Day)9-10 hrs, 5,100 m/18,139 ft

Day 11: Reserve DayDay 13: Reserve Day

Day 12: Trek to Manang and Drive to Basisahar, 7-8 hrs, 760/2,493 ft
